Scarcliffe House is a therapeutic Children's Home, currently going through the registration process with Ofsted to support up to 5 children with Learning Disability and Autism. The children may have additional diagnosis including but not inclusive of, Sensory Processing Difficulties, Demand Avoidance, Obsessiveness, ADHD, and behavioural difficulties. The Children are aged between 7 and 17 years of age.

While living within our Children's Home, Children will have the opportunity to experience a safe, nurturing, and valuing environment. There will be boundaries and structured care delivered by skilled support staff that are able to provide close supervision. We also have a full therapy team onsite to meet the needs of the children and work closely with staff to provide well rounded care based on our therapeutic model for the children's home.

We have extensive experience working in a variety of children settings. Our admission process starts with carrying out a highly specialised assessment and we use a variety of methods to engage children.

We provide a therapeutic placement based on our therapeutic model to help children grow and develop life skills, stabilise their behaviour, improve in social engagement and interactions and to have a healthy sense of being part of the community.

Tailored House Design

We consider our spaces special for development and growth. We have planned the layout of the house to provide a safe environment, both physically and emotionally. Careful consideration has been placed on what we provide and our spaces are heavily incorporated into this aspect.

Soteria Children's Services have a full therapy team and the support staff are trained in therapeutic interventions. The whole staff team follow a therapeutic model that provides children with a safe environment to have excellent day to day experiences and opportunities to progress in their health, education and emotional, social and psychological wellbeing.

Family Kitchen

Our family kitchen provides children with experiences to help them develop independent living skills. We take every opportunity to help children to prepare for their futures. Our family kitchen provides a warm caring environment for mealtimes.






Living Room

Our living room provides a nice warm welcoming and relaxing space for children. This space helps children to be part of the family experience at Scarcliffe House.

Cinema Room

We want children to have fun and enjoy their time with us. We have a cinema room to enhance their experiences and help to bring the excitement to them. We aim to provide opportunities to have tailored experiences and group experiences.



Sensory & Therapy Room

Therapy needs to be carried out in a space private confidential place. We have two therapy rooms. One of the therapy rooms is sensory integration focused. We also have many options within the grounds to provide therapeutic space. Our therapy team will provide tailored care for each child.

We have a dedicated sensory integration room to meet the sensory needs of our children. We have an Occupational Therapist who can provide input to create sensory schedules for children.

Our staff are upskilled and instructed how to deliver therapeutic strategies on a daily basis to proactively support our children to develop independence with their needs.



Bedrooms

Bedrooms are a private space for children, and we respect this aspect. They have some furniture already in their bedrooms, but they will be invited to pick out furniture and decorations to suit their style. We aim to listen to children's wishes and they can decorate their bedroom according to their taste.



Each of the bedrooms have an en-suite and suitable places to do their homework, watch TV and play games. They will have ample space for their belongings and clothes. We will help children to look after their space and keep it tidy. We will take every opportunity to build life skills for the future.



Communal Area's

We have lots of space around the house that can be safe spaces to retreat or enjoy being around others. There are two great communal areas and we have a family room that is perfect for when visitors come and there is a need for a separate space.

Children can use these spaces as much as they need. We have excellent communal spaces outside too and they provide an inviting environment with the big trees and green areas in our garden.



Therapeutic Garden Space

We have added more play equipment, chickens, swim spa, and a bouncy castle. We have a dedicated space for growing vegetables and plants. We have a park (swings and slide) and a zip wire swing through the garden. This is enjoyed by children and young people and adults.
